

# AYEA 2014

## Asian Young Endoscopist Award

## ◆ Description

Asian Young Endoscopist Award (AYEA) provides partial financial support to endoscopists outside Korea to receive clinical training in GI Endoscopy at selected endoscopic training centers in Korea to promote advancement and collaboration among participating Asian Societies of GI endoscopy. Grants are to be used for travel to and from the training center as well as for incidental expenses related to the training including housing

## ◆ Purpose

Provide funding for endoscopic training so that an endoscopist can acquire or develop new knowledge or a technical skill about GI Endoscopy. This newly acquired knowledge or endoscopic skill would then be used to improve patient care in the applicants' region.

## ◆ Eligibility

Asian physicians who are not residing in Korea and who are working in GI Endoscopy are eligible to apply together with his/her training institution.  
All applicants must be able to communicate effectively in English.

## ◆ Training period, Award and Number of awardees

## ◆ Benefits

1. Full travel grant (3,000 USD for 2 weeks)
2. Endoscopic training program at an outstanding endoscopy center of Korea
3. Free registration for the Young Endoscopist Forum (May 30, 2014)
4. Free registration for IDEN 2014 (May 31 ~ June 1, 2014)

## ◆ Duties (besides training)

1. An English presentation (6 minutes, topics related to GI Endoscopy) during the Young Endoscopist Forum (May 30, 2014)
2. Submission of evaluation sheets after training

## ◆ Guidelines for Application

1. Applicants should apply to their preferred field of participation; UGI endoscopy, LGI endoscopy, ERCP or EUS
2. Training center of each applicant will be selected by the committee of KSGE
3. Required documents
  - 1) Complete an application form including a written personal statement on the reasons for seeking training (Application form can be downloaded at IDEN 2014 website, [www.iden.or.kr](http://www.iden.or.kr))
  - 2) Curriculum vitae including a recent photo
  - 3) Two letters of recommendation: one from your training preceptor/director; and the other from the president of your society of GI endoscopy
  - 4) Lists of published articles written in English (last 5 years)
  - 5) A photocopy of your passport showing the photograph and identification information
4. Completed applications and all correspondence should be mailed to the IDEN 2014 Secretariat address listed below
5. Visa and Travel Insurance is the responsibility of the applicant.

## ◆ Review Process

Awards will be given by a special committee of the KSGE and will be based upon the applicant's credentials and their bright potential for enhancing the field of GI endoscopy in the applicant's home country.

## ◆ Deadline

Applications are due by **March 15, 2014**. The awardee will be notified after **March 30, 2014**.
